1	It was first between 220–206 BC by the first Emperor of China.
2	It is mainly dominated by Longevity Hill (60 meters high) and the Kunming Lake. But you can find a variety of palaces, gardens, and other classical-style architectural structures.
3	It is Beijing national stadium and it was designed for use throughout the 2008 Summer Olympics and Paralympics.
4	For almost five hundred years, it served as the home of the Emperor and his household
5	It served as a summer resort for Empress Cixi, who used a huge sum of money, said to be originally designated for the Chinese navy into the reconstruction and enlargement of this place.
6	It is the largest city square in the world (440,000 m ² - 880 m by 500 m)
7	It is the world's largest steel structure and all 110,000 tons of steel were made in China.
8	It was built originally to protect the northern borders of the Chinese Empire against intrusions from the north
9	The whole complex is only painted with two colours: red and yellow. Red signifies Happiness and yellow signifies Earth. Yellow was exclusively used by the imperial families at time.
10	The central Kunming Lake covering 2.2 square kilometers was entirely man made and the excavated soil was used to build Longevity Hill.
11	Despite the lack of significant events, this place appears to be quite profitable, drawing some 20,000 to 30,000 people a day at the price of a 50 yuan admission.
12	Built in 1406 to 1420, the complex consists of 980 surviving buildings with 8,707 bays of rooms.
13	The square is named after the Tian'an gate (literally means the Gate of Heavenly Peace) which sits to its north separating it from the Forbidden City.
14	Earth was represented by a square and Heaven by a circle; several features of the temple complex symbolize the connection of Heaven and Earth, of circle and square.
15	Trees line the east and west edges of it, but the square itself is open, with neither trees nor benches.
16	The entire of it, with all of its branches, stretches for 8,851.8 km.
17	The temple complex was constructed from 1406 to 1420 and the building is completely wooden, with no nails.
18	It was where the Emperor prayed for good harvests.
